



Tone in Tone Embroidery **First the embroidery then the dyeing**

We are frequently asked how the embroidery thread we supply reacts to subsequent dyeing.

The following should be noted:

1. Embroidery thread and fabric should be made of the same raw material.

For cottons we recommend our cotton thread **COTTY**, Colour 156. On man-made fabrics we recommend our rayon thread **SULKY**[®], Colour 1071.

2. Different materials react differently to dyeing. For this reason it is advisable to test beforehand.
3. All embroidery threads are treated with a lubricant. The dyer should remove this finish before dyeing.

If you follow these instructions we are sure that your tone in tone embroidery will be a complete success.
